### **CHILD PROTECTION SUNDAY**

In 2018 the Australian Catholic Church marks Child Protection Sunday on 9 September. That Sunday concludes National Child Protection Week.

This year is of particular importance for the Catholic Church in Australia and the Diocese of Maitland-Newcastle, as Child Protection Sunday follows on the heels of the formal response of the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference (ACBC) and Catholic Religious Australia (CRA) to the recommendations of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse and the release of the advice provided to Church Leaders by its Truth Justice and Healing Council.

Whilst the Church's response overwhelmingly accepted or accepted in principle or supported the Royal Commission's recommendations, much of the media have chosen to focus on the one recommendation that the Church has not accepted, compromising the seal of the Sacrament of Penance.

Child Protection Sunday affords an opportunity for the Diocese to complement that National Catholic Response with factual information on how we as faith communities actively participate in the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults.

As part of National Child Protection Week, the Diocese has developed interactive electronic noticeboards (called 'padlets') that will allow you and any interested parishioners, to watch brief audio-visual presentations, review documents, look at images and

get online advice from key agencies such as Family and Community Services and NAPCAN.

This year is the transition phase from participating in the Royal Commission and its inevitable focus on our past failings, to being focused on the present and continuing to build for the future, imagining a Church that is truly safe for children and vulnerable adults.

To paraphrase Fr Hans Zollner SJ, President of the Centre for Child Protection at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, we must grow to understand that safeguarding is at the heart of the Mission, it must become embedded in the DNA of our Church.

St Benedict's Parish, Inner Newcastle is committed to ensuring that our parish, and all our activities are child-safe, and will respond to any concern or allegation promptly and appropriately. The first point of contact for any concern is Fr Andrew or the Parish Office.

## SCRIPTURAL CONTEXT

### Isaiah's Prophecy

All three synoptic gospel writers were at pains to demonstrate that Jesus was the fulfilment of the prophecies of the scriptures. This reference to Isaiah's prophecy appears in all three synoptic gospels. It is perhaps most familiar in the context of the Gospel of Luke, where the gospel writer actually combines it with a different passage from Isaiah and portrays Jesus as reading it in the synagogue as an announcement of his mission (Lk 4: 16-21). It is good to have the Isaiah text as the first reading this week and then see the way it is referred to in the gospel of the day.

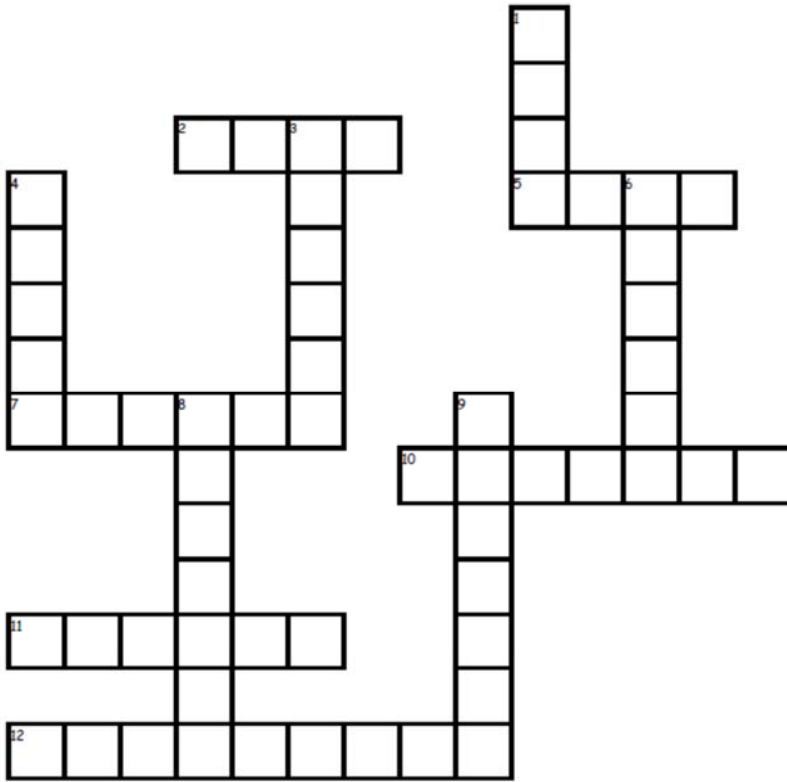
